

# The White Cockade

Bars

(32 Bar Reel)

- 1 - 8      1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> couple, with near hands joined, set and giving right hands to your partner, cross over then set and giving right hands to your partner cross back to original place.
- 9 - 16     1<sup>st</sup> couple lead down the middle and up again to top place in the middle of the dance.
- 17 - 20    1<sup>st</sup> couple cast off to second place on their own side.  
2<sup>nd</sup> couple step up on bars 19 - 20.
- 21 - 24    1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> couples dance four hands round to the left.
- 25 - 32    2<sup>nd</sup> and 1<sup>st</sup> couples dance rights and lefts.

Repeat having passed a couple.
