- Please note that all memberships expire on January 31st each year. So if for example, you join the Society on June 1st, your (\$30) membership would last 8 months.
- Membership of the Society entitles you to discounted ticket prices to the Society's events, as advised. For example, members usually save \$20 per ticket on their St Andrew's day Ball tickets, \$20 per ticket on the Burns Supper tickets and \$10 per ticket on their Chieftain's Ceilidh tickets – a saving of \$100 a year to a couple.

- Members have the right to become involved in the running of the Society and are eligible to stand for membership of the Committee.
